  - o How do burdens or concerns in our lives help shape our calling?
  - o Nehemiah responds to this burden with prayer. How does prayer play a role in discerning our vocation?
  - o What do you notice about Nehemiah's posture toward God and his people? How might humility and faithfulness shape how we live out our vocations?
- o Read Hebrews 12:1-3 – Hebrews 12 urges us to run our race with endurance.
  - o How does this relate to choosing a vocation?
  - o The passage speaks of "laying aside every weight and sin" that hinders us. What distractions or fears often hold people back from fully embracing their calling?
  - o How does fixing our eyes on Jesus help us navigate challenges in our work or calling?
